Smoky Lake County moves towards renewable energy

In the May 11 county meeting, Smoky Lake County Council discussed the amendment of their existing land use bylaw regarding renewable and alternative energy. At this meeting, the public could object to or approve of the proposed amendment. In this bylaw, the county takes a significant step towards developing alternative or renewable energy. Jordan Ruegg, Planning and Development Officer of Smoky Lake County, explained the purpose of the hearing:" The purpose of this hearing is to obtain public feedback in opposition of or support for bylaw number 1436-23. The bylaw goes way beyond the existing bylaw for alternative energy, targeting solar, wind and geothermal energy, all primary alternative energy sources. The current land use bylaw lacks several requirements, policies and provisions to move forward". The county will support partnerships with educational institutions

and industry to establish renewable energy projects. The county also promotes partnerships and encourages the microgeneration of renewable energy resources. A significant part is watershed management and restoration, or maintaining planning initiatives and management plans. The county will partner with indigenous communities to proceed and execute the bylaw. Another avenue is to seek to protect and restore aquatic ecosystems. This change broadens the possibility of alternative energy systems, seeking an alternative to fossil fuel systems. It also includes alternative personal means to generate energy, such as solar panels. "Alternative energy, personal, means any system, device, or structure used to collect natural energy resources, such as the sun, wind, or geothermal, to generate thermal, electrical, or mechanical energy to use as an alternative to fossil fuels and other non-renewable resources. Typical examples

are, but are not limited to, personal solar energy conversion systems, personal wind energy conversion systems, and personal geothermal energy conversion systems, " as it says in the summary of changes. "A Geothermal Energy Conversion System, Personal means a power generation facility consisting of any system, device or structure that utilizes a heat pump to warm or cool air by utilizing the constant temperatures of the Earth to generate electrical power for onsite consumption requirements, either on or off-grid, and may provide residual power to the grid but is not intended to produce power primarily for resale." Jordan emphasizes that the municipal role is quite limited: the jurisdiction for approval of these projects is done through the Alberta Utility Commission (AUC), the municipality does not have much say in it all. No members of the public attended this meeting; two submitted their thoughts by email.


