# Historic church burned to the ground

On Friday, April 18, a fire began in the centre of Radway AB. It was rumoured that a routine yard work task took a tragic turn when an individual, while using a traditional burning method to dispose of leaves and grass clippings, inadvertently lost control of the fire. Although

this was not the cause of the fire, it ultimately led to the devastating destruction of the historic church in downtown Radway.

The local volunteer firefighters responded with remarkable speed and unwavering dedication. Their relentless commitment ensured that the fire was contained to mostly the church, preventing it from engulfing adjacent homes. Fortunately, (although there was damage to neighbouring homes)no residential properties were lost, and thankfully, there were no injuries reported among the residents or responders.

The church, which had been serving as a storage facility, suffered complete devastation along with a few vehicles and several garages located on the property. At one stage, the scene was overwhelmed with emergency response vehicles, their lights flashing against the darkening sky, as they lined the street in a concerted effort to keep the fire from spreading throughout the town.

In the end, while the physical loss was minimal compared to what could have

transpired, this unfortunate incident stands as a stark reminder of the importance of vigilance and caution. It highlights the necessity of avoiding open flames and other igniting materials during periods of dry conditions and strong winds. The event served as a wake-up call for the entire community to prioritize safety and be aware of potential hazards.

# Seeds to Sprouts opens new building

Seeds to Sprouts Childcare Society proudly hosted its Open House at its new, spacious location in Thorhild on April 25, marking a significant milestone in its journey.

Previously housed at Thorhild Central School, the daycare has expanded its offerings with the new facility, designed to accommodate children aged 0 to 3.5 years, while the school site will continue to cater to 3 to 4-vearolds. This arrangement provides seamless transitions for children who require daycare services while also being enrolled in playschool or kindergarten programs. allowing them to transition between rooms within the same building.

In a bold move to enhance

its facilities, Seeds to Sprouts made a strategic decision to invest its reserves to purchase the new building, officially gaining possession on November 10, 2024. Renovations commenced immediately, with teams entering the premises just two days later on November 12. Thanks to a series of creative fundraisers, sponsorships, a poker tournament, and the tireless dedication of community members, the building underwent a remarkable transformation. Finished renovations were completed swiftly and efficiently by the end of February 2025, allowing the daycare to open its doors to eager local families on April 7, 2025. 

# Town of Smoky Lake receives grant

The Town of Smoky Lake has proudly secured a generous \$211,520 grant from the Government of Ministry Alberta's of Immigration and Multiculturalism to launch an ambitious two-year plan known as the Newcomer Navigation Supports Program. This program aims to significantly enhance the community's capacity, enrich avenues for information-sharing, and cultivate a spirit of intercultural inclusion—all while providing newcomers with the tools to seamlessly access essential resources and promote a profound sense of belonging in their new home.

At the heart of this initiative is a dedicated Newcomer Navigation

Facilitator, whose role will be crucial in establishing connections with schools, local businesses, health services. libraries, and various organizations within the community. This facilitator will work to ensure that resources are not only accessible but are also culturaling the diverse backgrounds and needs of newcomers. "Smoky Lake is a community that welcomes growth while staving true to its roots," said Amy Cherniwchan, Mayor of Smoky Lake. "This initiative gives us the tools to grow thoughtfully, by strengthening the way we connect with newcomers and ensuring every resident feels informed, included, and proud to call Smoky Lake home."

Focused on enhancing community awareness and forging solid partnerships, the program will roll out newcomer-friendly materials, host engaging intercultural events, and create smoother pathways to vital serly responsive, reflect- to strengthen the way we connect as a community," said Rachelle Amvotte, FCSS Director. "It's about building systems that feel welcoming, inclusive, and easy to navigate for anyone who chooses to make Smoky Lake home."

Set to launch in the spring of 2025, this program seeks to attract newcomers and also to nurture their long-term retention and successful integration into community.

The grant will fully support a full-time position dedicated to this mission over two years, with a particular emphasis on developing community capacity. This role will prioritize collaboration with employers and service providers, vices. "This funding focusing on training gives us the chance and capacity- building initiatives rather than offering one-onone support to individuals relocating to the area. The overarching aim of this position is to substantially increase the number of cultural events and programming available, ultimately creating rich and dynamic opportunities for both newcomers and existing residents to create meaningful connections and feel a deep sense of belonging within Smoky Lake.







